

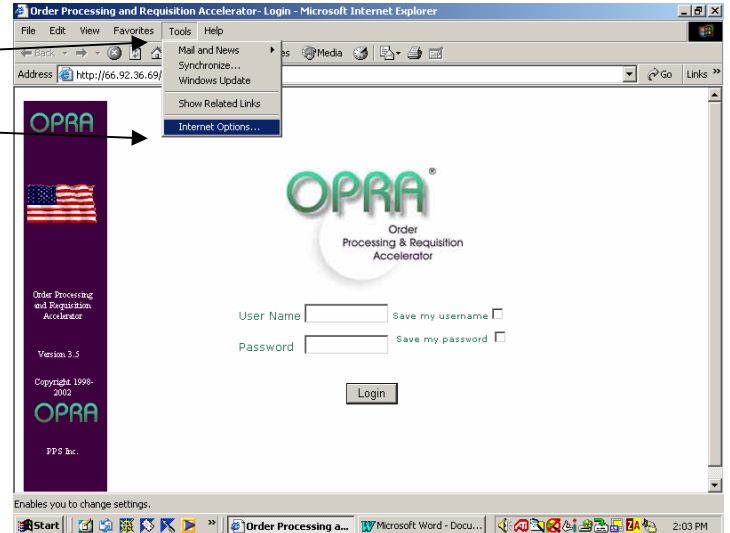
BROWSER MAINTENANCE & HOUSEKEEPING

Depending on certain settings, your browser may be collecting hundreds or thousands of temporary junk files and cookies. Sometimes excessive files and cookies can cause problems with, not only OPRA, but when browsing anywhere on the Internet. It is a good idea to clean these files out from time to time. Here's how you do this in Internet Explorer:

Select tools from IE's menu bar.

Select Internet Options

The screen shown below will appear

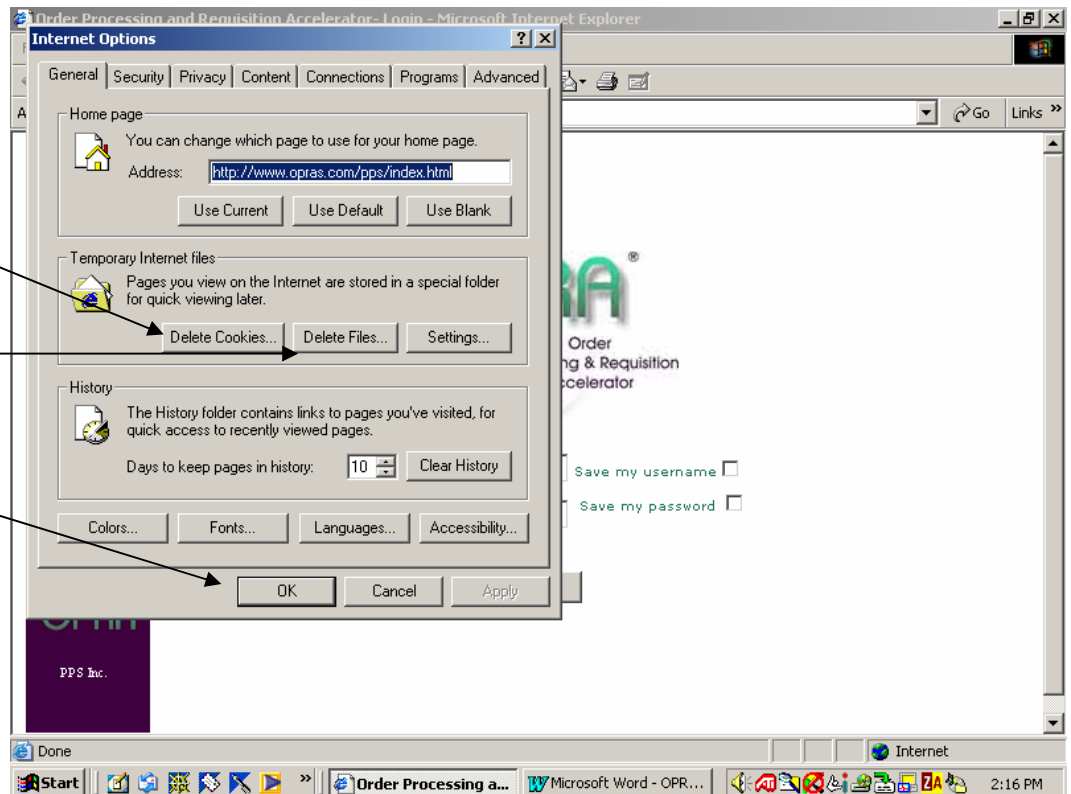


Click on the Delete Cookies button (note that this feature is not present in IE 5.0 or earlier versions)

A confirmation popup will appear (click yes to delete cookies)

Now click on the Delete Files button – say yes to confirm the deletion of temporary Internet files.

Click on OK to complete & exit the tool popup



How often should I do this? That depends on how much you surf the net and if others use your machine. For most users, once a month is OK. If you're experiencing problems surfing the net this is a good procedure to follow.

NOTE: You do not need to be logged on to OPRA during this procedure. If you are logged on OPRA will ask you to log on again after the procedure.
